To avoid identification, some persons are not linked at the level below the municipal level. These persons have been assigned to a DeSO within their municipality.

Equivalised disposable income :

Incomes are equivalised, which means that the household disposable income is adjusted for household size by using a weight system. The unit of measurement is equivalised disposable income for persons.

Disposable income is the sum of all taxable and tax-free income minus taxes and negative transfers. Capital gains/losses are included, that is, the gain/loss arising from a sale (realization) of assets, for example, stocks, mutual funds or real estate.

At-risk-of-poverty rate :

The at-risk-of-poverty rate is the share of people with an equivalised disposable income below the at-risk-of-poverty threshold, which is set at 60 % of the national median equivalised disposable income

High economic standard :

The high economic standard rate is the share of people with an equivalised disposable income higher than 200 % of the national median equivalised disposable income.

The nationwide divisions DeSO (Demographic Statistical Areas) and RegSO (Regional Statistical Areas) apply from 1 January 2018 and 1 June 2020, respectively, and follow the county and municipal borders. RegSO has been created by aggregating DeSO. Further information on DeSO and RegSO can be found on Statistics Sweden's website.

Between 2014 and 2015, there is a change in the method used to connect people to a specific DeSO. Before 2015, property coordinates were used, while address coordinates is used in 2015 and subsequent years. This means that there will be a minor break in the statistics on DeSO and RegSO between 2014 and 2015.

Update 2021-07-02:

Two RegSOs (regional statistical areas) have new designations. RegSO Dala-Järna, with RegSO code 2021R001, has changed its designation to Vansbro västra landsbygd.

RegSO Vansbro västra landsbygd, with RegSO code 2021R003 has changed its designation to Dala-Järna.

This update applies from 2021-07-02.

Income from wages, salaries and pensions from the Nordic countries is included for people who are registered in Sweden. As of the publication of the income year 2020, the statistics for the years 2011-2019 have been revised.
