As the LFS is a sample survey, all estimations are subject to uncertainty. Uncertainty in estimations based on fewer than 20 observations on a monthly or quarterly basis or fewer than 40 observations on a yearly basis may be considered too large and the estimation is not reported. In these cases, the value is replaced with two periods [..].

As of 1 January 2021, the LFS is carried out in accordance with the new EU framework regulation. This means there is a break in time series between 2020 and 2021.

The self-employed group includes self-employed persons who have either some form of sole proprietorship, or persons who are freelancers. Family worker includes persons who work without pay in some company belonging to a household member.

observations: Margin of error \pm , 1000s: The presented margin of error corresponds to a 95 percent confidence interval.

Because the LFS is a sample survey based on a national random probability sample, there is a degree of uncertainty that can be calculated. The presented information consists of estimations and consideration must be taken to uncertainty/margin of error when drawing conclusions. The interval that is created by the level estimation \pm margin of error here is a 95 percent confidence interval, which is an interval with a 95 percent probability including the actual value.
