Description

Individuals are considered to be residents in Norway when they have taken up residence here or intend to stay here for at least 6 months and have a valid residency permit. From March 1987 to January 1994, asylum seekers were considered as residents in Norway, even if their application for a residency permit had not been processed. Before and after this period, only asylum seekers with residency permits were registered as residents.

Three measures are available. Use the Measure button to select:

1. Number of persons

2. Per cent = Percentage

3. Ratio (Norway = 100) = Ratio between the municipality's proportion and the national proportion for a given year. Examples; ratio = 130 means that the municipality's proportion is 30% higher than the national level. A ratio of 87 means that the municipality's proportion is 13% lower than the national level.

Comments to data published nov-23:

The handling of "grunnkrets", the basic geographical unit used to build municipalities and city districts, is modified. This can lead to changes in data, especially for the years before 2003.

Comments to previously published data Jan-2023:

The time series is updated using a new method of standardisation: Indirect standardisation using the national population for the last available year as standard. The previous method had a fixed year as standard, and used direct standardisation. Accordingly, figures may differ from what was published previously. Changes in the figures can also be due to revisions in the source register, and to correction of previous errors in the data delivered from the source register. The handling of small numbers is revised. This can lead to other data cells being hidden than in previously published data.

Rationale for indicator

Many of the indicators in NorHealth are related to population composition.

Notes

As of December 2022 the same dataset is published in Norhealth as in the Kommunehelsa statistics bank. Due to this, Norhealth now has data for municipalities and city districts added, while data for health regions have been removed.

Collection

The statistics are based on information from the National Population Register. The National Population Register is updated partly by the local Population Register offices, which are connected to the Register via terminals and partly by the Norwegian Tax Administration. Statistics about changes in the population are based on the electronic copies of update notifications sent to Statistics Norway.

Data quality

The quality of the data from the National Population Register is generally very good for statistical purposes. Certain groups, however, are registered with a different residence than their actual domicile. In many cases this is because the registration rules are not followed (moving not reported). In other cases, the registration rules do not provide an actual address e.g. unmarried students who, according to the rules, should be registered as living at the parental home.

When numbers are missing

For technical reasons, the number of years in the time series is limited to 24. When a new year is added, the earliest year must be deleted.
