Annual earnings are based on employess who are the all year within the same sample unit and full-time at least 10 months of the year. Annual earnings are computed to 12 months earnings.

Overtime pay are overtime payments in Annual earnings.

Irregular pay are payments not payed in each pay period in Annual earnings.

The average is the weighted mean, taking into account sample weights.

The median divides a distribution of an ordered group by wages or working hours into half, and in a similar way the quartiles divide it into four equal parts.

One quarter of the group has lower wages or working hours than lower quartiles (L.quartiles) and one quarter of the group has higher wages or working hour than upper quartiles (U.quartiles).
