These figures depict registered students in programmes that are a part of the annual data collection by Statistics Iceland. The data include duplicate counts. Students can be counted more than once if they are registered in different schools, in different programs or in different modes of teaching.

Year:

2004: In autumn 2004 the duplicate count was about 6.6% for students in schools at the upper secondary level.

2005: In autumn 2005 the duplicate count was about 6.3% for students in schools at the upper secondary level.

2006: In autumn 2006 the duplicate count was about 7.1% for students in schools at the upper secondary level.

2007: In autumn 2007 the duplicate count was about 7.6% for students in schools at the upper secondary level.

2008: In autumn 2008 the duplicate count was about 8.2% for students in schools at the upper secondary level.

2009: In autumn 2009 the duplicate count was about 8.0% for students in schools at the upper secondary level.

2010: In autumn 2010 the duplicate count was about 7.0% for students in schools at the upper secondary level.

2011: In autumn 2011 the duplicate count was about 7.7% for students in schools at the upper secondary level.
