Footnotes for Table SA06 (SIC Series 1998-2001)

1. The estimates for 1998-2001 are based on the 1987 Standard Industrial Classification (SIC).

2. Total average compensation per job is compensation of employees received divided by total full-time and part-time wage and salary employment.
 3. "Other" consists of the wage and salary disbursements of U.S. residents employed by international organizations and foreign embassies and consulates in the United States.
 4. Under the 1972 SIC, ordnance was reclassified to four 2-digit industries: Fabricated metal products, electronic and other electric equipment, transportation equipment, and instruments and related products.
 5. Under the 1987 SIC, combined real estate, insurance, etc., was reclassified to four 2-digit industries: Nondepository credit institutions; insurance agents, brokers, and services; real estate; and legal services.
 6. "Social services" was first recognized under the 1972 SIC, so estimates for 1969-74 do not exist.
 7. "Engineering and management services" was first recognized under the 1987 SIC, so estimates for 1969-87 do not exist.
- All state and local area dollar estimates are in current dollars (not adjusted for inflation).
 - **(D)** Not shown to avoid disclosure of confidential information, but the estimates for this item are included in the total.
 - **(L)** Less than \$50,000, but the estimates for this item are included in the total.
