Notes:

- 1. The <u>labour force</u> refers to those persons who were either employed or unemployed during the week (Sunday to Saturday) prior to Census Day (May 16, 2006).
- 2. The <u>employment level</u> is the number of persons who, during the week (Sunday to Saturday) prior to Census Day (May 16, 2006), did any work at all for pay or in self-employment or without pay in a family farm, business or professional practice; or, were absent from their job or business, with or without pay, for the entire week because of a vacation, an illness, a labour dispute at their place of work, or any other reasons.
- 3. Percentage change

Percent change between, for example, 2001 and 2006 is calculated as follows:

- 4. The <u>employment rate</u> for a particular group (age, sex, marital status, geographic area, etc.) is the number of persons employed in the week (Sunday to Saturday) prior to Census Day (May 16, 2006), expressed as a percentage of the total population in that particular group.
- 5. The <u>unemployment rate</u> for a particular group (age, sex, marital status, geographic area, etc.) is the unemployed in that group, expressed as a percentage of the labour force in that group, in the week (Sunday to Saturday) prior to Census Day (May 16, 2006).
- 6. The <u>labour force participation rate</u> for a particular group (age, sex, marital status, geographic area, etc.) is the total <u>labour force</u> in that group, expressed as a percentage of the total population in that particular group.
