Clusters of houses up to a distance of 400 metres from the centre of the urban settlement which naturally belong to the settlement may nonetheless be included.

#2 The geographical area of activity of the Sami Development Fund North of Saltfjellet. Based on the 2005 definition of the SDF area.

#3 Areas North of Saltfjellet, corresponding to the eleven northernmost electoral constituencies of the Sami Parliament of Norway, which are not defined as areas of activity for the Sami Development Fund.
