Special care facilities
Refers to nursing homes, residences for senior citizens, and chronic and long-term care and related facilities.

Correctional and penal institutions
Refers to correctional and penal institutions, jails, establishment for delinquents and young offenders, and police lock-up facilities.

Shelters
Refers to shelters for abused women and children, shelters for persons lacking a fixed address, and other shelters and lodging and rooming with assistance services.

Other service collective dwellings
Refers to school residences and residences for training centres, YM/YWCAs, hostels and other establishments with temporary accommodation services, and campgrounds and parks.

Other Refers to work camps, staff residences and oil rigs at sea, military bases, merchant and government vessels, and other collectives dwellings such as outfitter camps.

Total - Collective dwellings

A collective dwelling refers to a dwelling of a commercial, institutional or communal nature. It may be identified by a sign on the premises or by a census representative speaking with the person in charge, a resident, a neighbour, etc. Included are lodging or rooming houses, hotels, motels, tourist homes, nursing homes, hospitals, staff residences, communal quarters (military bases), work camps, jails, missions, group homes, and so on. Collective dwellings may be occupied by usual residents or solely by foreign and/or temporary residents.
