Concepts and definitions

Description

Quality description

These statistics apply the regional division of 1 January 2013 to the whole time series. Data for annexed municipalities have been combined, with the exception of the sub-area annexing of Längelmäki into Orivesi and Jämsä. The entire population of Längelmäki has been combined with Jämsä in 1992-2005. Hence the data of the time series is not comparable for the regions of Pirkanmaa and Central Finland as well as for the municipalities of Jämsä and Orivesi.

Sipoo partial municipal merger 2009

On 1 January 2009 an area of 29,1 km2 belonging to the municipality Sipoo was merged with Helsinki.

Hence the data of the time series is not comparable for the municipalities of Helsinki and Sipoo.

Family type

Families are grouped into the following types: - married couple without children - cohabiting couple without children - married couple with children - cohabiting couple with children - registered male couple without children - registered male couple with children - registered female couple without children - registered female couple with children - mother with children - father with children. A married or cohabiting couple without children refers to a couple who has never had any children or whose children no longer live with their parents. Cohabiting couple with children contains couples who have common children and also couples whose children are not common. For reasons of data protection, those

living in registered partnerships are grouped together with married persons in municipal tables.

Cohabiting couple without children

Cohabiting couples (marriage like relationship) have to be inferred from the Population Information System without knowing the nature of their living together. Cohabiting couples are formed of two spouseless over 18-year-olds of different sex occupying the same dwelling on a permanent basis, provided their age difference is less than 16 years and they are not siblings. The fact that the Population Information System does not indicate whether a person living with a family is a subtenant, makes it more difficult to conclude families. People of the same sex living together are not regarded as cohabiting. Only registered partnerships are recorded in the statistics.

Sex

A man with a family is a married or cohabiting partner, a father with children and both partners of a registered male couple. A woman with a family is a married or cohabiting partner, a mother with children and both partners of a registered female couple.

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
