ISCED: International Standard Classification of Education i.e. United Nation's system of classification of education. Initially adopted by UNESCO in 1976, revised in 1997. ISCED is an instrument suitable for compiling statistics on education internationally. It covers two cross-classification variables: Levels and fields of education.
