Footnotes

- Citizenship refers to the legal citizenship status of a person. Citizenship can be by birth or naturalization. A person may have more than one citizenship. A person may be stateless, that is, they may have no citizenship.
- 2 Includes persons who are stateless.
- Period of immigration refers to the period in which the immigrant first obtained his or her landed immigrant/permanent resident status. A landed immigrant/permanent resident refers to a person who has been granted the right to live permanently in Canada by immigration authorities.
- Non-immigrant refers to a person who is a Canadian citizen by birth.
- Immigrant refers to a person who is or has ever been a landed immigrant/permanent resident. This person has been granted the right to live in Canada permanently by immigration authorities. Some immigrants have resided in Canada for a number of years, while others have arrived recently. Some immigrants are Canadian citizens, while others are not. Most immigrants are born outside Canada, but a small number are born in Canada. In the 2011 National Household Survey, 'Immigrants' includes immigrants who landed in Canada prior to May 10, 2011.
- Includes immigrants who landed in Canada prior to May 10, 2011.

- Non-permanent resident refers to a person from another country who has a work or study permit, or who is a refugee claimant, and any non-Canadian-born family member living in Canada with them.
- Age at immigration refers to the age at which an immigrant first obtained landed immigrant/permanent resident status. Immigrant refers 8 to a person who is or has ever been a landed immigrant/permanent resident. This person has been granted the right to live permanently in Canada by immigration authorities.
- The places of birth selected are the most frequently reported by immigrants at the Canada level.
- Non-immigrant refers to a person who is a Canadian citizen by birth. 10
- Immigrant refers to a person who is or has ever been a landed immigrant/permanent resident. This person has been granted the right to 11 live in Canada permanently by immigration authorities. Some immigrants have resided in Canada for a number of years, while others have arrived recently. Some immigrants are Canadian citizens, while others are not. Most immigrants are born outside Canada, but a small number are born in Canada. In the 2011 National Household Survey, 'Immigrants' includes immigrants who landed in Canada prior to May 10, 2011.
- The official name of United Kingdom is United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United Kingdom includes Scotland, Wales, <u>12</u> England and Northern Ireland (excludes Isle of Man, the Channel Islands and British Overseas Territories).
- China excludes Hong Kong Special Administrative Region and Macao Special Administrative Region. 13
- The official name of Viet Nam is Socialist Republic of Viet Nam. 15 The official name of Iran is Islamic Republic of Iran. 14
- The official name of South Korea is Republic of Korea. 16
- The category 'Oceania and other' includes places of birth in Oceania and responses not included elsewhere, such as 'born at sea.' 17
- The category 'Other places of birth' includes other places of birth in Oceania and responses not included elsewhere, such as 'born at sea.' <u>18</u>
- Non-permanent resident refers to a person from another country who has a work or study permit, or who is a refugee claimant, and any 19 non-Canadian-born family member living in Canada with them.
- Recent immigrants are immigrants who landed in Canada between January 1, 2006 and May 10, 2011. Immigrant refers to a person who 20 is or has ever been a landed immigrant/permanent resident. This person has been granted the right to live in Canada permanently by immigration authorities. Some immigrants have resided in Canada for a number of years, while others have arrived recently. Some immigrants are Canadian citizens, while others are not. Most immigrants are born outside Canada, but a small number are born in Canada. The places of birth selected are the most frequently reported by recent immigrants at the Canada level.
- 21 The official name of Venezuela is Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela. 22 The official name of Moldova is Republic of Moldova.
- <u>23</u> The official name of Syria is Syrian Arab Republic.
- Generation status refers to whether or not the person or the person's parents were born in Canada. It identifies persons as being first 24 generation, second generation or third generation or more.
- 'First generation' includes persons who were born outside Canada. For the most part, these are people who are now, or have ever been, <u>25</u> immigrants to Canada.
- 'Second generation' includes persons who were born in Canada and had at least one parent born outside Canada. For the most part, these 26 are the children of immigrants.
- 'Third generation or more' includes persons who were born in Canada with both parents born in Canada. 27
