Type of ownership The topic 'Type of ownership' refers to the ownership of the dwelling and not to that of the land on which the dwelling stands.

'Owner-occupied dwellings' are those where at least one occupant of the dwelling owns parts or the whole of the dwelling.

'Cooperative ownership' refers to ownership within the framework of a housing cooperative.

'Rented dwellings' are those where at least one occupant pays a rent for the occupation of the dwelling, and where no occupant owns parts or the whole of the dwelling.

Type of building The topic 'Dwellings by type of building' refers to the number of dwellings in the building in which the dwelling is placed.

Density standard (floor space) The topic 'Density standard' relates the useful floor space in square metres or the number of rooms to the number of occupants, as specified under the topic 'Number of occupants'.
