Footnotes:

1. Source: Aboriginal Peoples Survey 2012.
2. The Inuit population includes persons who reported being "Inuk (Inuit)" in the Aboriginal Peoples Survey either as their only Aboriginal identity or as part of a multiple identity including "Inuk (Inuit)" and "First Nations" and/or "Métis".
3. Inuit Nunangat is the homeland of Inuit of Canada. It includes communities in Nunatsiavut (Northern coastal Labrador), Nunavik (Northern Quebec), the territory of Nunavut and the Inuvialuit region (Northwest Territories). These regions collectively encompass the area traditionally occupied by Inuit in Canada.
4. Excludes persons living on Indian reserves or settlements.
5. Proxy reporting was used in the 2012 Aboriginal Peoples Survey for nearly half of youth aged 15 to 17 years and for adults in certain specific situations (for example when the selected adult was not able to answer for health related reasons, due to a language barrier, or because the selected respondent was going to be away from home for the duration of the survey.)
6. All percentages for the variable "smoking status" are calculated using the number of persons in "total, smoking status" as denominator.
7. Respondents were asked the following question: "At the present time, do you smoke cigarettes daily, occasionally or not at all?".
8. "Smoker" refers to smokers of cigarettes only.
9. Non-smokers, in other words those persons who answered "Not at all" to the question "At the present time, do you smoke cigarettes daily, occasionally or not at all?", were asked: "Including both household members and regular visitors, does anyone smoke inside your home, every day or almost every day?". This included current non-smokers who did not live with at least one other person.
10. Second-hand smoke includes smoke from cigarettes, cigars and pipes.
11. "Not specified" categories consist of item non-response ("Refusal", "Don't know", and "Not stated").
12. Bootstrapping techniques were used to produce the coefficient of variation (CV).
13. Data with a coefficient of variation (CV) from 16.6% to 33.3% are identified by an (E) and should be interpreted with caution.
14. Data with a coefficient of variation (CV) greater than 33.3% were suppressed (F) due to extreme sampling variability.
