- Global non-response rate (GNR), short-form census questionnaire: 8.3%

- Global non-response rate (GNR), long-form census questionnaire: 8.7%
- Data quality index showing a long-form income non-response rate higher than or equal to 10%, but lower than 20%.

Non-migrants are persons who did move but remained in the same city, town, township, village or Indian reserve. Migrants include internal migrants, who moved to a different city, town, township, village or Indian reserve within Canada. External migrants include persons who lived outside Canada at the earlier reference date.
